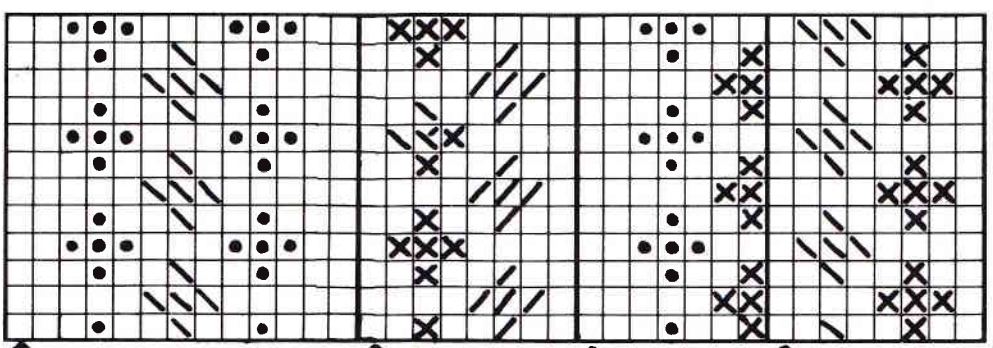


Next Round: P with SC.

 sts.

Cut yarn, thread through sts, draw up and
 fasten off. Fold back turn up.

TUNIC, LEG WARMERS AND CAP

Materials:

Lopi 100 gram ball
600 grams M
300 grams C
300 grams SC
300 grams TC

These quantities are sufficient for all garments.

Circular needle No. 4 (6 mm)
Set of 4 No. 4 (6 mm) needles with points both ends.

Measurements:

To fit 86.3 (91.5, 96.5) cm bust

(34" 36" 38" inch)

Actual Sizes: 95, 98, 101.5 cm

Length to armhole 40 cm. See note on adjustment.

Sleeves 51 cm including cuff. Length may be adjusted by turning back more or less at cuff.

Sizes:

Figures in () refer to larger sizes. Where only one figure is given this refers to all sizes.

Tension:

13 sts and 18 rounds to 10 cm square.

Tension Check:

Before commencing knit a sample in st st using No. 4 (6 mm) needles. Change to larger or smaller needles if required to obtain the correct tension noting that it is especially important to obtain the correct number of rows for this design.

Abbreviations:

K-knit, P-purl, st(s)-stitch(es), patt-pattern, beg-beginning, foll-following, rep-repeat, cont-continue, rem-remaining, dec-decrease, inc-increase(ing), st st-stocking stitch, M-main colour, C-contrasting colour, SC-second contrasting colour, TC-third contrasting colour.

TUNIC

Back and Front

With circular needle and M cast on 124 (128, 132) sts.

Mark beg of round. Work 2 rounds in K1, P1 rib then work two rounds in P1, K1 rib. Now work in stripe patt I.

Stripe Patt I

P11 rounds in the foll colours:—

1st Round: C
2nd Round: M
3rd Round: SC
4th Round: C
5th Round: M

6th Round: SC
7th Round: TC
8th Round: SC
9th Round: TC
10th Round: M
11th Round: C

Note: If extra length to armhole is required it may be added here by repeating the last 4 rounds as required allowing 2 rounds for each extra CM required.

When stripe pattern I is completed work chart Patt I (13 rounds in st st) then work stripe Patt II.

Stripe Patt II (16 rounds)

1st Round: P with TC
2nd Round: P with C
3rd Round: P with TC
4th Round: P with C
5th Round: P with TC
6th Round: P with C
7th and 8th Rounds: with M, * K1, P1;

rep from * to end
9th and 10th Rounds: with M, * P1, K1;

rep from * to end
11th Round: P with SC

12th Round: P with C
13th Round: P with SC

14th Round: P with C
15th Round: P with SC

16th Round: P with C
When stripe patt II is completed work

chart patt II (8 rounds in st st) then work stripe patt III.

Stripe patt III (17 rounds)

1st Round: P with SC

2nd Round: P with C

3rd Round: P with M

4th Round: P with SC

5th Round: P with TC

6th Round: P with M

7th Round: P with C

8th Round: P with M

9th Round: P with SC

10th Round: P with M

11th Round: P with SC

12th and 13th Rounds: With TC *K2, P2,

rep from * to end.

14th and 15th Rounds: With SC * K2, P2,

rep from * to end.

16th and 17th Rounds: With M * K2 P2;

rep from * to end.

When stripe patt III is completed work chart patt III (7 rounds in st st). Leave sts

on needle.

Sleeves

With set of needles and M cast on 40 sts.

Mark beg of round, K1 round.

Cuff

1st & 2nd Round: P with M

3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th Rounds: K with M

7th & 8th Rounds: K with TC

9th Round: K with SC

10th Round: K with M

11th Round: K with TC

12th Round: K with C

13th Round: K with SC

14th Round: K with M

15th Round: K with C

16th Round: & 17th Round: K with SC

18th & 19th Rounds: K with TC

20th & 21st Rounds: K with M

22nd & 23rd Rounds: K with C

Cuff is now completed. Cont in patt as in back and front beg at 5th round of stripe patt I and ending when chart patt III has been completed.

slip last 4 and first 5 sts of round on to a safety pin. Leave stitches on needle (31 sts).

Yoke

Place first 9 sts from circular needle on a safety pin. Slip sts of one sleeve on to right

hand end of circular needle, slip next 53 (55, 57) sts on to same end of needle, place next 9 sts on a safety pin, slip sts of second

sleeve on to right hand end of circular needle then slip rem sts on to same end of needle. 168 (172, 176) sts.

Now work stripe patt IV.

Stripe patt IV (16 rounds)

1st Round: P with TC

2nd Round: P with SC

3rd Round: P with M

4th Round: P with SC

5th Round: P with TC

6th Round: P with C

7th & 8th Rounds: With SC* P1, K1; rep

from * to end.

9th & 10th Rounds: With SC* K1, P1 rep

from * to end.

11th Round: P with M

12th Round: P with C

13th Round: P with M

14th Round: P with C dec 32 sts evenly 136

(140, 144) sts.

15th Round: P with M

16th Round: P with C

When stripe patt IV is completed work

chart patt IV (8 rounds in st st) dec 28 sts

evenly in last row 108 (112, 116) sts, now

work stripe patt V.

Stripe patt V (13 rounds)

1st Round: P with TC

2nd Round: P with M

3rd Round: P with TC

4th Round: P with C dec 28 sts evenly 80

(84, 88)

5th Round: P with M

6th Round: P with SC

7th Round: P with TC dec 18 (20, 22) sts

evenly 62 (64, 66) sts.

8th Round: P with M

9th Round: P with TC

10th & 11th Rounds: P with C

12th Round: P with SC

13th Round: P with SC dec 4 (6, 6) sts

evenly 58 (58, 60) sts.

When stripe patt V is completed cont with

M only working 6 rounds in K1 P1 rib for

neckband. Cast off loosely in rib.

To Make Up

Graft tog sts under arms. Fold first 4 rounds at lower edge to wrong side and slipstitch in position. Turn back cuffs at 12th row or as required for length.

LEGWARMERS

With set of needles and M cast on 40 sts. Mark beg of round. Work 12 cms in K2 P2 rib. Cont in patt as in Back and Front of tunic beg with stripe patt I until the 10th rounds of stripe patt II has been worked, Inc 1 stitch at each end of 11th round. Now work chart patt III then stripe patt VI.

Stripe patt VI (11 rounds)

1st Round: P with TC inc one st at each

end of round

2nd Round: P with M

3rd Round: P with SC

4th Round: P with C

5th Round: P with M

6th Round: P with TC

7th Round: P with SC

8th Round: P with M

9th Round: P with TC inc 1 st at each end

of round 46 sts.

10th Round: P with C

11th Round: P with TC

Cast off with TC

CAP

With set of needles and M cast on 60 sts. Mark beg of round K1 round. Work turn up as cuff of sleeves then work chart patt I followed by first 5 rounds of stripe patt II. Next Round: With M *K1, P1; rep from * to end.

Dec 12 sts evenly in first row. Work chart

patt III, 48 sts.

Next Round: P with TC dec 12 sts evenly

36 sts.

Next Round: P with SC.

Next Round: P with M dec 18 sts evenly, 18

sts.
