- We use appropriate safety equipment, such as hearing protection, protective clothing, and personal protective equipment.
- We record accidents, update, and follow safety plans.
- We have a safety committee with safety officers and safety representatives.

Good Communication

Communication channels must be clear, and interactions must be straightforward. We want an intense information flow so that all potential hazards are always brought to light.

Facilities and Safety

A safe working environment and the safety of employees and visitors are always priorities, as there are many factors to consider. We require that facilities, equipment, and tools meet risk and safety requirements.
